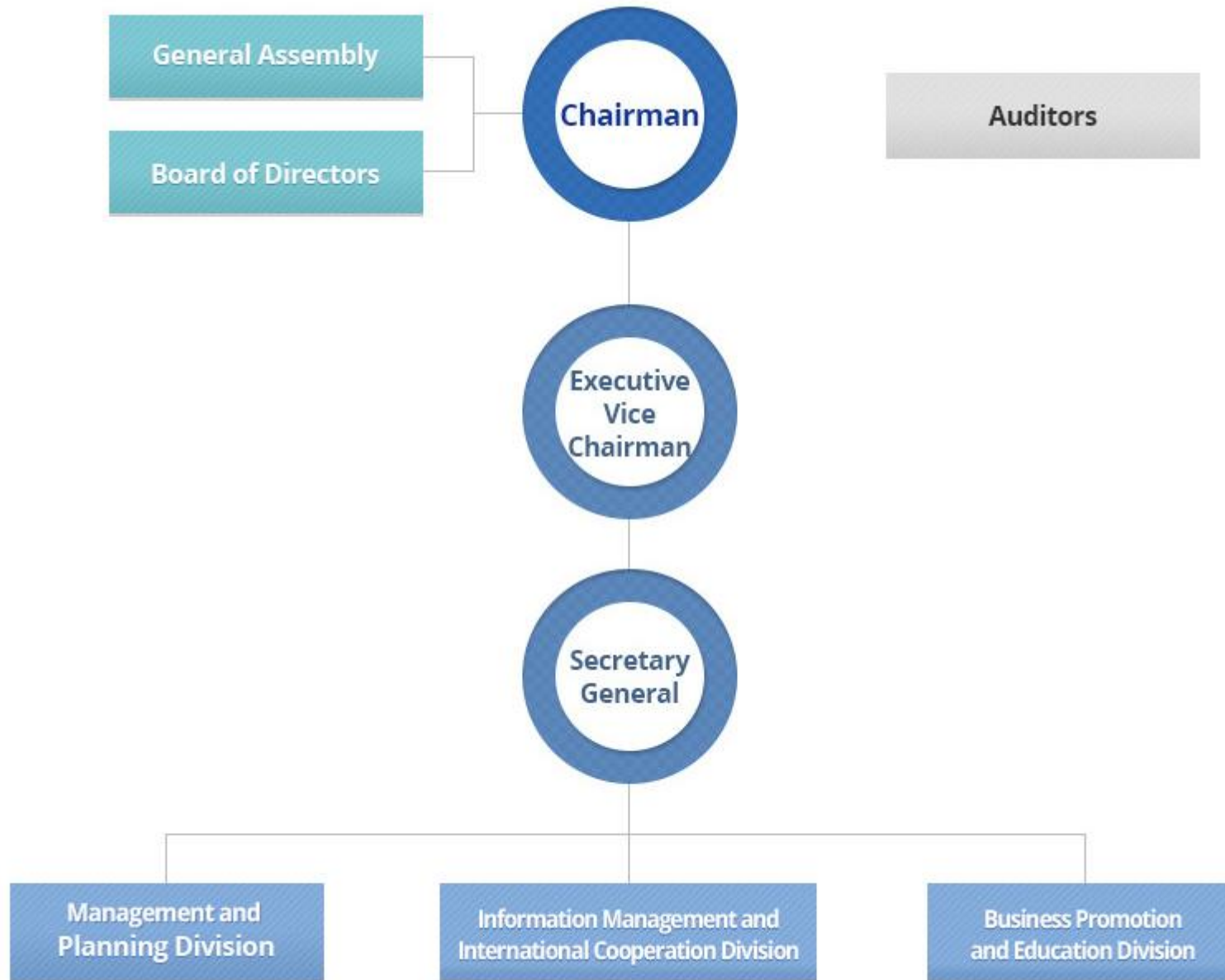

- **The Korea Atomic Industrial Forum (KAIIF) has been established since 1972 as a non-profit private organization to be dedicated to the promotion of the peaceful use of nuclear energy in Korea.**
- **The key objectives are to create a relationship between and among the organizations involved in nuclear industry and help them promote joint efforts and cooperation for the development of the nuclear industry.**



- **KAIF comprises 122 corporate and 236 individual members as of July 1, 2019 representing the electric utilities, industrial companies, engineering and construction companies, research institutes, professional associations and foreign companies' affiliates in Korea.**

- Award annually the Nuclear Technology Prize to individuals and organizations who contributed to the promotion of nuclear industry and the enhancement of nuclear technology
